Project Requirements:

- Research report (written in class)
- Artifact (prepared/created at home)
- Presentation board (prepared at home)
- Five minute oral presentation (prepared at home)
- Powerpoint presentation (created in class)



Artifact Suggestions

- Create a piece of art that showcases an element of your country’s culture
- Share a game that is traditionally played in your country
- Find a creative way to present your country’s flag
- Use plaster of Paris, clay, or paper-mache to showcase something from your country
- Learn a song from your country and present it to the class
- Share an artifact from an important holiday or celebration
- Learn a traditional dance from your country and present it to the class
- Show an example of clothing from your country
- Make a traditional dish from your country and share photos of the cooking process as well as photos of the final dish (*food cannot be shared with the class)
- Use craft materials to create a model of a famous landmark
- Create an illustration that shows something important about your country (history, culture, landmarks, etc.)
- Make an artifact of your choice. Be creative! Your artifact should teach us something about your country.



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Presentation Board

For your presentation board, you must include
at least one element from each of the
following areas:

Social Studies

- Describe an important event in your country’s history
- Explain how your country’s government is organized
- Write about your country’s climate and landforms

Text Features

- Timeline
- Diagram
- Pictures/Photos (with caption)
- Fact box
- Graph, chart, table
- Headings

Writing

- Write a short diary entry describing a child’s typical day in your country
- Write a letter to a friend describing how you would celebrate an important holiday in your country
- Write a paragraph persuading a friend to visit a famous landmark in your country
- Describe an important tradition in your country and explain its meaning/origin
- Write a biographical paragraph about a famous citizen of your country
